TPPR

In the past, there's always been a division between USPSA and IPSC shooters that has kept us apart. The purpose of this shooting sport is to bring them together in a fun and balanced way, without scarifying the competitive spirit of both practical shooting sports. To accomplish this, we've created TPPR; a hybrid rule book that will allow IPSC and USPSA shooters to participate in the same event without altering their equipment.

General Competition Rules

1. Individual stage walkthroughs or stage inspections are not allowed.
2. Taking a sight picture prior to the start signal is allowed. Such sight picture is only permitted no more than one step from the "Make Ready" location.
3. Unless otherwise specified in the stage briefing, the start position is:
 - Handguns: standing erect, arms relaxed at sides and firearm holstered.
 - Carbines: standing erect with the buttstock of the firearm touching the belt.
4. Shortcuts are not allowed. Any competitor who takes a shortcut by stepping on the ground outside the shooting area will incur one procedural penalty for each shot fired after beginning the shortcut.
5. Increased or decreased angles of fire on specified targets are allowed.
6. If a course of fire stipulates shooting strong or weak hand only, a competitor will not be penalized for using the other hand to scoop the firearm.
7. The use of camouflage is discouraged, except by military personnel.
8. Recognized categories are: Junior, Senior, Super Senior and Lady.
9. Classifications are as per your highest achieved on either IPSC or USPSA.
10. Scores are kept by electronic means using *Practiscore*.
11. All IPSC and USPSA approved targets are allowed.
12. All IPSC and/or USPSA range commands may be used.
13. All other IPSC and USPSA rules apply.

Production Division

- Maximum ammunition capacity
 - Minor: 15 rounds
 - Major: N/A
- No handgun size limit
- No barrel length limit
- No magazine length limit
- No trigger weight limit
- Magnets are allowed
- Race type holsters are allowed
- Minimum Power Factor
 - Minor: 125 PF
 - Major: N/A
- Must be on either the USPSA or IPSC Approved Production Handgun List.
- All USPSA and IPSC Production firearms are allowed.

Production Optics Division

- Maximum ammunition capacity
 - Minor: 15 rounds
 - Major: N/A
- No handgun size limit
- No barrel length limit
- No magazine length limit
- No trigger weight limit
- Magnets are allowed
- Race type holsters are allowed
- Minimum Power Factor
 - Minor: 125 PF
 - Major: N/A
- Must be on either the USPSA or IPSC Approved Production Handgun List
- All USPSA Carry Optics and IPSC Production Optics & Production Optics Light firearms are allowed.

Classic Division

- Maximum ammunition capacity
 - Minor: 10 rounds
 - Major: 8 rounds
- No handgun size limit
- No handgun weight limit
- Magnets are allowed
- Race type holsters are allowed in this division
- Minimum Power Factor
 - Minor: 125 PF
 - Major: 165 PF
- All USPSA Single Stack and IPSC Classic firearms are allowed

Standard Division

- Maximum ammunition capacity
 - Minor: 19 rounds
 - Major: 17 rounds
- No handgun size limit
- No magazine length limit

- No restrictions on position of holster and allied equipment, yet the heel of the butt of the handgun must be above the top of the belt.
- Minimum Power Factor
 - Minor: 125 PF
 - Major: 165 PF
- All USPSA Limited and IPSC Standard firearms are allowed

Open Division

- Maximum magazine length limit: 171.25 mm
- Minimum Power Factor
 - Minor: 125 PF
 - Major: 160 PF
 - Minimum bullet weight: 112 grain
- All USPSA and IPSC Open firearms are allowed

Pistol Caliber Carabine Division

- Maximum ammunition capacity
 - Minor: 32 rounds
 - Major: N/A
- No magazine length limit
- Maximum bullet velocity: 1,600 FPS
- Slings are not allowed
- Sig Brace and any variant thereof is not allowed
- Minimum Power Factor
 - Minor: 125 PF
 - Major: N/A
- No minimum bullet weight limit
- Permitted calibers: 9x19, .357 Sig, .38 Super, .40 S&W, 10 mm & .45 ACP
- All USPSA and IPSC Pistol Caliber Carabine firearms are allowed
